

2021 Southern District ITE Organization Chart





Should SDITE meet more than once per year inperson?








Should SDITE meet twice per year: in-person in the spring and virtually in the fall

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











Did you find the Past Presidents' Committee mentoring sessions useful?












How frequently should SDITE offer training (PDH/AICP credits)?








In regards to training, please rank the following areas most important (1) to least important (5).








Which area would benefit you most at this stage of your career?
